## Operations Date (COD) of 1. Date of operationalisation of first facility i.e. 7th July 2020 to be adopted as COD and acceptance of Force Majure for same from Ramnagar Cluster. May 2020 to March 2021. 2. In case of acceptance of scenario 1 leading to shift in end date of contract, by 2 months, which actually is 9 months beyond end date of Project (Sept 23) thus provisions of additional funds (app. 22 Cr) would have to be made to sustain the intervention beyond project date. For this decision on either of the following funding mechanism can be adopted: a. World Bank may be requested to extend the funding for this extension (provided the PPP cluster is functional). b. State Government is requested to make provisions in case Bank does not concur on above (A). c. In case of non-concurrence on A or B (as above) contract can be severed as provisions of termination (as per article 20, clause 20.3 of MOU) at project end date i.e. September 2023.
